

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Chaperones may bring in laptops/iPads & backpacks (emergency contacts, medical forms, etc.) **Wi-Fi capabilities*!**
- Movies will be available in Golden Bear Theatre

Illnesses/ First Aid:

- In the instance a student becomes ill a chaperone will be notified and be directed to the First Aid Station located next to DC Universe.
- If an illness is considered major and the student needs to go to a hospital a chaperone will be required to accompany them to the hospital as well as contact their parents/guardians.

Students with Special Needs:

- Please complete the Special Exceptions form for any student requiring assistance.
- Wheelchairs are available for rent. Wheelchair rentals are located behind the Guest Relations building in Six Flags Plaza.
- Six Flags' Attraction Access Program is designed to accommodate guests with disabilities or certain other qualifying impairments so they may participate in the enjoyment of our Parks. For more information on how to obtain an Attraction Access Pass see below:

To receive an Attraction Access Pass you must have a note from a doctor. You will only need this note the first time you request an Attraction Access Pass. Your doctor should include the following information:

- Doctor's name
- Address of the doctor's practice (Printed stationary is OK as long as it includes the Doctor's medical ID number)
- Phone number of doctor's practice (Printed stationary is OK as long as it includes the Doctor's medical ID number)
- Name of person requesting the Attraction Access Pass
- Statement indicating the guest has a disability or other qualifying impairment under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and/or applicable state law that prevents the guest from waiting in a standard queue.
- Valid time period of disability (permanent or, if temporary, the valid time period the Pass is needed for)
- Doctor's signature
- **The note must NOT describe or indicate the nature of the disability.**

Bring your note to the Ride Information Center (Guest Services) just inside the front gate of the park. A photo identification must be presented at the time of issuance. For children under the age of 16, a student photo ID will be acceptable. You will only need to present your doctor's note the first time you visit a U.S. Six Flags theme park.

Special Exceptions:

- Completed Special Exceptions Form must be submitted one week prior to date of event.
